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Impact of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana in Entrepreneurship Development with Special Reference to Chhindwara District

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Abstract: Unemployed youth in India are looking to overcome financial constraints to set up start-ups. To encourage entrepreneurship, the Government of India has launched the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (Prime Minister Skill Development Scheme).
