

Impact of NGOs on Rural Women: A Sociological Study Special Reference to Ajmer District

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Abstract: *The objective of the article is to analyze the impact of Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) on the mobility of Ajmer rural women in the public sphere, as this is an area where only men generally come, while women are confined to their homes and neighborhoods. Lives. In other words, the author explored how, and to what extent, NGOs have brought about changes in women's freedom of movement in the public sphere. The authors were influenced by existing literature that portrays Ajmer as a district characterized by poverty, patriarchy and inequality, where rural women have no tradition of participating in the labor force, and where women's mobility is severely restricted. In this study, indicators of women's mobility were explored which included the movement of women in various public places such as markets, medical centres, children's schools and cinemas.*
