The Act was amended via the Maternity benefit (Amendment) Act, 2017. The modification has brought in important modifications to the law relating to maternity advantages. Those are: It extends the period of maternity benefit from 12 weeks to 26 weeks of which now not extra than 8 weeks can precede the date of the predicted delivery. This exceeds the global Labour organization's minimum wellknown of 14 weeks and is a nice improvement. but, a woman who has or greater surviving kids might be entitled to 12 weeks of which no longer greater than six weeks can precede the date of the predicted shipping. Women who legally undertake a infant underneath the age of three months or a "commissioning mom" may be entitled to maternity gain for 12 weeks from the date on which the kid is surpassed over to her. A commissioning mom is defined as a biological mother who makes use of her egg to create an embryo implanted in another girl. It offers discretion to employers to permit women to do business from home after the period of maternity gain on together agreeable situations. It introduces a provision which requires every established order to intimate a woman at the time of her appointment of the maternity advantages to be had to her.
