

Formulation and Evaluation of Herbal Shampoo from Fermented Rice Water and its Anti-Fungal Activity

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Abstract: *The most common problem these days is hair loss, so the primary goal of the study is to reduce hair loss and promote hair growth. The essential element of this study is fermented rice water (Oryza sativa), which includes significantly extra antioxidants than pure rice water.
