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Status of Women in the Agrarian Sector

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Abstract: The present review article is aimed at studying the various trends and patterns that are emerging from the Indian agriculture sector due to the changing role of women in Indian agriculture system. Globally we find nearly half of the agricultural workforce is that of women in spite of that they have to face discrimination at both societal levels and within their own households, which has profound effects on their Right to Food.
