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Last Bencher's Self Attitude: A Reflective Analysis Among Secondary School Students

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Abstract: The modern global class room teaching method oriented towards students. In present scenario , the teachers are unable to manage class properly. Even educationist and academicians designed innovative method of classroom management. But there is gap between teacher and students in terms of classroom teaching learning process. Generally the first bench filled with toppers and last bench occupied with low achievers. The present study focus on last benchers attitude. The hypotheses were framed. 1. There is no significant difference between male and female last bench students of secondary schools with regard to their self attitude. 2. There is no significant difference between male and female and female teachers attitude towards last bench students. The study revealed that the secondary school last bench male students significantly high in self attitude score (t=19.1204, p<0.05) at 0.05% level of significance. The secondary school female teachers significantly high in teacher attitude scale (t=21.1309, p<0.05) at 0.05% level of significance. the female parents significantly high in 'parent attitude scale' score (t=15.2305, p<0.05) at 0.05% level of significance. The study concluded that male students need to counseled and male teachers and male parents should develop positive gesture towards last benchers
