The best thing of the herbal cosmetics is that it is purely made by the herbs and shrubs and thus is sideeffects free. The natural content in the herbs does not have any side effects on the human body; instead provide the body with nutrients and other useful minerals. Serum is one of the cosmetic products with very high concentration of active ingredient in their formula for providing intensive nutrition to the deeper skin layer and non-greasy finish product which suitable for skin. Herbal toilet article is more preferred and is employed within the repairmen of the many ailments of hair. They promote hair growth, improve elegance of hair and forestall hair fall. Moisturizers are topically applied products designed to increase the water content of the skin. Ingredients used in these products have a range of actions, including preventing transepidermal water loss and promotion of desquamation. Moisturizer application smooth's skin surface by filling spaces between partially desquamated skin flakes and restores the ability of the intercellular lipid bilayers to absorb, retain and redistribute water. The primary purpose of lip balm is to provide an occlusive layer on the lip surface to seal moisture in lips and protect them from external exposure. Dry air, cold temperatures, and wind all have a drying effect on skin by drawing moisture away from the body. Lips are particularly vulnerable because the skin is so thin, and thus they are often the first to present signs of dryness.

### **II. METHODOLOGY**

Procedure of Herbal Hair Serum Formulation: first we cleaned all the glasswares and dried them properly. Then measured the accurate quantity of aloe vera and transferred it into the beaker. Mixed the required quantity of vit E in aloe vera. Then mixed rose water to the mixture of aloe vera and vit E and stirred it for few min. After that heated the prepared solution for few minutes. Then added few drops of glycerine and strirred with the help of magnetic stirrer. After all this the prepared solution was transferred into the measuring cylinder for volume adjustment. Then stored the serumin an air tight container.

Procedure of Herbal Lip Balm: All the materials were weighed accurately on a digital balance. Preparation method opted for the preparation of herbal lip balm stick was of heating solid raw ingredients at consistent temperature with indirect flame bees wax was crude and grinded into small uniform size and was melted in 50 ml beaker in indirect flame with an highest temperature of 90°C. All other ingredients like vitamin E, Beetroot extracted powder (dry), Rose essence, Aloe vera were mixed vigorously and added to the mixture and mixture was stirred continuously till homogenous mixture was obtained and was poured into balm stick moulds just before pouring glycerine was applied over the mould with cotton. The moulds were kept in ice bath aside for about an hour in cool and dry place indirect to sunlight till it solidifies and was used after 48 hours after keeping at room temperature for stability and analytical testing.

Procedure of Herbal Moisturizer: First of all, for the formulation of herbal cream we have to collect different types of glassware like beaker, spatula, measuring cylinder, petri dish or different types of equipment like stirrer mixer etc. After that we have to extract pure Aloe vera gel from leaves of *Aloe barbadesis miller*. Then we have to make three different formulations in different batches F1, F2, F3. In F1 we will use Aloe vera gel (1gm), glycerine (2 drops), rose water (2 drops), vitamin E capsule (1 drops). In F2 we will use Aloe vera gel (4gm), glycerine (3drops), rose water (2drops), &vitamin E capsule (2 drops). In F3 we will use Aloe vera gel (7gm), glycerine (2drops), rosewater (3drops), &vitamin E capsule (3 drops). We mainly use glycerine because it acts as a moisturizing agent. Rose water work as a skin toner and gives a vital role as a fragrance. Vitamin E capsule prevents sunburns and improves skin growth.

Comparative Study of Synthetic and Herbal Cosmetic Products: Measurement of pH: The pH of Cosmetic products were determined in order to investigate the possibility of any side effects. The pH study was carried out by dissolving 1gm of sample into 100 ml water. The pH measurement was done using pH strip. pH of lip balm was near to neutral (6.5) pH of hair serum was near to neutral (7.5) pH of moisturizer was near to neutral (7.0)

Skin Sensitivity - It was carried out by applying the product in the form of a patch on the skin for 30 min and observe the reaction as- No reaction Redness of the skin Itching, swelling inflammation.

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
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

Comparative texture of hair serum (a) prepared formulation (b) Skin story hair serum.








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Comparative texture of hair serum (a) skin story serum (b) Boutique hair serum
