II. METHODOLOOGY

Here's a formulation for a 100 mL herbal hair serum using the mentioned ingredients:

10 milliliters of rosemary extract (which promotes hair growth and enhances scalp circulation)

15 mL of flaxseed gel, which strengthens and hydrates hair

10 mL of black seed oil, which nourishes the scalp and lessens hair loss

Ten milliliters of fenugreek extract, which guards against dandruff and is high in protein and nicotinic acid

5 mL of vitamin E oil, which enhances shine and serves as a natural preservative

Aloe Vera Gel: 20 mL (hydrates hair and calms the scalp)

Rose Water: 30 mL (provides scent and serves as the serum's foundation)

STEPS TO PREPARE:

Create the Base: In a sterile, clean mixing dish, mix the aloe vera gel and rose water. To make a uniform liquid foundation, whisk until smooth.

Incorporate Herbal Extracts: Add the fenugreek extract, flaxseed gel, black seed oil, and rosemary extract gradually. Make sure all the ingredients are properly dispersed by giving it a good stir.

Add the vitamin E oil to include vitamin E. For a consistent consistency, thoroughly mix.

Bottle the Serum: Using a pump or dropper, pour the serum into a 100 mL glass or plastic bottle that has been sanitized.

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To maintain the natural qualities, store in a cold, dark location.





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HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Begin by shampooing your hair.
- 2. Pat your hair dry, but not completely.
- 3. Depending on the length of your hair, take a tiny amount.
- 4. Apply the serum on your palm to warm it up.
- 5. Use on hair.

EVALUATION PARAMETER –

1. Physical appearance:

The texture, color, and scent of the created cosmetic serum were assessed in order to gauge its physical appearance. [6]

2. Ph:

A digital pH meter will be used to determine the test's pH. A digital pH dipper will be inserted deeply into the serum formulation sample, and the pH value will be noted. Since the skin has an acidic pH of around, the formulation's pH should also be acidic.

3. Viscosity:

5 ml of the serum and a Brookfield viscometer set to 100 rpm are used to measure the formulation's viscosity. Before the measurement, the spindle will be immersed in the serum for approximately five minutes in a large mouth container. [13]

4. Spreadability test:

A parallel plate method, commonly used to evaluate and quantify the spread ability of semisolid preparations, was utilized to determine spreadability. A single gram of hair serum was sandwiched between two 20 x 20 cm horizontal plates, the upper of which weighed 125 g. After one minute, the spread diameter was measured. The following formula was used to determine spreadability: [14]

 $S = m \times 1 / t$

5. Test of stability

For three months, the herbal hair serum was stored at two different temperatures—4± 2°C and 30± 2°C—with a relative humidity of 65%. After three months, the herbal hair serum's pH and viscosity were measured and compared to the initial values. [15]
